





MUNICIPALITY OF PENNE: CONTEXT ANALYSIS

- Penne is a small town of 12.199 citizens in the Province of Pescara within the Abruzzo Region;
- It is within the "Borghi più belli d'Italia" and the "Città Slow" and it is "Città d'Arte e degli Arazzi";
- There are 4.690 families, 4% of the population is foreign; the per capita income in 2016 was just over 15.000 euros;
- The resident population is 12.199 citizens, plus 515 foreigners (Romanian No. 231, Pole No.48, British No.40, Slovak No.1 -female-, Macedonian No.40, Albanian No.20, Moroccan No.11, Tunisian n.11, Nigerian n.9, other nationalities n.104); families with at least one foreigner are No.317;
- 21% of the population is elderly (65 years of age), 13% are young (up to 14 years), 65% are between the ages of 15 and 65;
- There are No.7.883 entreprises, of which: No.209 in the industrial sector (artisanal), No.103 in the institutional sector, No.231 in the field of services, No.240 others;
- In the Abruzzo Region, the number of employed decreased by 3,7% (between 2016 and 2017); the employment rate in the first quarter of 2017 was 53,9%; the unemployment rate was 13,7%; the inactivity rate was 37,4%;
- The data shows a very fragile regional production system. The innovation hubs and enterprises network involved micro-enterprises and employ 52% of the employees. An improvement of micro-enterprise competitiveness and the attractiveness for medium and large enterprises are needed.
